Energy summit set Nov. 29

► State officials plan a broad focus for the conference.

The Oklahoma Corporation Commission will host a forum this month to address issues facing the state's energy industry and ultimately influence energy policy.

"My greatest hope for the energy conference is that we will begin a conversation with every citizen," said Commissioner Jim Roth.

Roth said the conference could be the first of many in the state, which counts energy as one of its chief industries.

Oklahoma Energy Summit 2007, "The Way Forward: Developing Oklahoma's Energy Portfolio," will bring together industry leaders and policy makers to discuss fossil fuels, alternative energy, conservation and electricity transmission.

The commission developed the summit with input from representatives of state government, and environmental and consumer groups.

The event is scheduled Nov. 29 at the Oklahoma History Center in Oklahoma City.

Panel discussions at the summit will blend longstanding elements of the state's oil and gas industry with

emerging technologies.

For instance, the summit will pair an expert on marginal wells with a representative of AEP-PSO to discuss carbon sequestration.

Marginal wells are the state's most mature wells and the foundation for Oklahoma's oil production. An average marginal oil well in Oklahoma produces less than three barrels of oil per day, and a marginal gas well less than 60,000 cubic feet of natural gas per day.

The wells, however, comprise about 85 percent of the state's oil production and 10 percent of its total natural gas production.

American Electric Power-Public Service Company of Oklahoma, one of the state's largest electric utilities, will address how carbon captured from its power plants can be used to stimulate oil production.

The utility announced last month that it had agreed with a subsidiary of Tulsa-based SemGroup LP for the delivery and use of carbon dioxide from its coal-fired power plant in Oologah.

Robert Wegener, Oklahoma's deputy secretary of energy, said the summit will bring together industries whose interests overlap.

"I think it's interesting to see how industries grow and intersect with each other," he said.

A fossil fuel component was important to include in the summit be-

cause that industry "is part of the past, present and the future of the state," Wegener said.

Gross production taxes from the oil and gas industry are projected to contribute about \$1 billion to the state this year.

But the summit will also focus on issues that have not been as widely discussed in Oklahoma, including energy conservation and efficiency.

The Corporation Commission took the first step last month to require utilities to submit plans encouraging energy conservation and efficiency among customers.

A panel titled "The Cheapest Choice: Energy Conservation and Efficiency" will include speakers knowledgeable in policy considerations, the environment and utility costs.

Other panels will focus on nuclear and wind energy, and bioenergy.

Corporation Commission Chairman Jeff Cloud said it is important to include a variety of energy sources when discussing energy policy.

"We're going to need it all, if you think long-term," he said.
