# Bishop Kelley Auction features trip to Rome

**Master of Illusion**, for DS: Ladies and gentlemen, gather 'round. The show is about to begin.

As you can see, I have nothing up my sleeves, but watch me speak the magic words and presto-change-o, where my left hand was just a moment before is now a brand new game for the DS. Now if anyone sees my left hand, please get that to me, and call the paramedics while you're at it.

Master of Illusion is a DS game of a different variety. In its most basic form, it teaches you card tricks — and it even includes a special deck designed just for the game.

Beyond that, it actually serves as an assistant to a wide variety of tricks designed specifically for use with the DS. Each trick has its own secrets — we could give them away, but where's the fun in that?

If you feel like amusing yourself for a bit, check out the solo tricks section while the DS makes predictions it couldn't possibly know. Ready to perform for a crowd anywhere between one and Rhode Island? Time for you to try out the Magic Show mode.

The more you practice and perform, the more tricks you unlock, until you

**Cooking Mama 2: Dinner With Friends**, for DS: Mama's back in the kitchen with a brand new cookbook to crank out some homemade meals for every last one of her friends and family.

For those of you unfamiliar with the original, the game revolves around a series of minigames through-

out the preparation of a dish. For example, making waffles is a three-step process. First, mix the ingredients in a bowl (tap and stir till done). Next, rearrange items in the fridge to make room for the bowl. Finally, pour the batter into a waffle iron, and adjust as instructed.

There are 80 dishes in the game, each with its own unique recipes, from simple to more complex dishes like jambalaya or rice croquettes. You can even get together and cook with up to three of your friends to find out who's the best chef.

Despite following the same general theme through the entire game, Cooking Mama doesn't get stale — the speed and variety of the minigames keeps it fresh and bound to entertain folks of all ages.

The topic? Uh, Marvel — then, and now. Lee's the star of the show, but Smith checks in with his unbridled mania, a la his "Evening With" DVDs (don't worry, there's a cleaned-up version of the soundtrack available if kids are watching). They're joined by another Marvel legend, Joe Quesada.
