## Affiliations

### International Colleges and Universities

As a Christ-centered University for the education of the whole person . . . reaching out to every person's world with a message of healing, wholeness, and abundant living, Oral Roberts University has expanded its reach into every person's world by affiliating with international colleges and universities that have a like purpose.

Through the affiliation agreements, students qualified to be Oral Roberts University students are taught by faculty qualified to be Oral Roberts University faculty. These students complete equivalent courses

that qualify them to meet the degree requirements of Oral Roberts University students studying at the Tulsa campus. The degrees awarded are jointly granted by Oral Roberts University and the affiliated institution.

### *Livets Ord University, Uppsala, Sweden.*

Founded by President Ulf Ekman, Livets Ord University is a distinctively Christian university whose purpose is to provide an evangelical Christian alternative that includes receiving a quality liberal arts education in Europe. Livets Ord University offers the bachelor of arts degrees in three majors: higher Biblical studies, humanities and social studies, and history.

### *Peniel College of Higher Education, Brentwood, Essex, England.*

Founded by President Michael Reid for the purpose of providing an evangelical Christian alternative to students who would otherwise receive a secular liberal arts education in the United Kingdom, Peniel currently offers the bachelor of arts degree in Higher Biblical Studies.

ORU is a member of the Council for Christian Colleges and Universities (CCCCU), an international higher education association of intentionally Christian colleges and universities with 105 members in North America and 74 affiliate institutions in 23 countries. The members represent 28 different denominations.
