AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH WARRANT

The undersigned affiant, being first duly sworn, upon oath deposes and says that the following described property: blood sample, hair sample

that constitutes evidence that an offense was committed and that the person in possession thereof participated in the commission of said offense, to-wit: Child Neglect,

The above described property is now in possession of the above named defendant, and is now located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, at, upon or within a certain vehicle, and or house, building, or premises, the curtilage thereof and appurtenances thereunto, belonging to: Linzy Leigh Earles

Described as follows: Blood sample/Head hair sample from Linzy Leigh Earles

Affiant states that there is probable cause for the issuance of a search warrant because, on July 28th, 2008, the victim, two-month-old Zane Allen Earles, was at his grandparent's residence located at [REDACTED] 102nd Street in Tulsa. That while there, the victim was in the care and custody of his mother, identified as seventeen-year-old Linzy Leigh Earles, who also lives at the above listed residence. That while in the care and custody of the defendant, two-month-old Zane Earles was left unattended in an infant swing on the opposite side of the house for approximately two hours after his grandfather went to work. That the defendant went back to her bedroom and slept in her bedroom which was approximately 65-85 feet away from her son's location after her father, identified as Stan Earls, left the residence at approximately 0830 hours. **That during this period of time, Zane Earles was left unattended, and a nine to twelve week old lab puppy that was left loose in the house ate the two month old victim.** The defendant has had a history of drug abuse and she was just recently taken off juvenile probation on 06/02/08 for drug charges. That while the victim was left unattended in the living room, the defendant was unable to wake up and hear her baby crying or screaming. That a blood sample and hair sample from the defendant could determine if the defendant was under the influence of alcohol or narcotics during the period of time her baby was left unattended and eaten, and she was unable to wake up to hear her babies screams prior to her baby's death.

Linzy Leigh Earles is described as a W/f, 503/104, Bln/Blu with a date of birth of 10/24/90, [REDACTED] and a last known address of [REDACTED] 102nd Street in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Wherefore, Affiant asks that a search warrant issue according to law, directed to any peace officer of this state, commanding that he search the said persons, premises and/or vehicle, and take possession of the property herein before described and detain the same provided by law.





AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH WARRANT

The undersigned affiant, being first duly sworn, upon oath deposes and says that the following described property:

- Decibel Sound Testing
- Body fluids

that constitutes evidence that an offense was committed and that the person in possession thereof participated in the commission of said offense, to-wit: **Child Neglect**

The above described property is now in possession of the above named defendant, and is now located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, at, upon or within a certain vehicle, and or house, building, or premises, the curtilage thereof and appurtenances thereunto, belonging to: **Stan Earles, Holly Earles, or Linzy Earles**

Described as follows:

A single family, single story, brick house, located in the 2900 block of E. 102nd Street. The house is constructed with red and white colored brick, with a dark gray shingle roof, and tan wood trim. The house faces north and is on the south side of E. 102nd Street. [REDACTED] The front door is dark in color. The numbers [REDACTED] are gold in color and located on the front of the house affixed on the upper west side of the garage door. This residence is commonly known as [REDACTED] 102nd Street, Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Affiant states that there is probable cause for the issuance of a search warrant because,

On Monday, July 28th, 2008 at approximately 1021 hours, Tulsa Police dispatch received a call from the **Emergency Medical Service Authority** requesting assistance in responding to a reported dog bite/animal mauling that occurred at [REDACTED] E. 102nd Street, in the City of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma. Tulsa Police officers responded to the scene and found two-month-old **Zane Earles** deceased inside the residence. Investigation revealed that he had suffered multiple dog bites and he had also been eaten alive by one of the animals kept inside the residence.

The victim, two-month-old Zane Allen Earles, was at his grandparent's residence located at [REDACTED] E. 102nd Street in Tulsa. That while there, the victim was in the care and custody of his mother, identified as **seventeen-year-old Linzy Leigh Earles**, and the grandmother, identified as **Holly Earles**, who also lives at the above listed residence. That while in the care and custody of the defendants, two-month-old Zane Earles was left unattended in an infant swing on the opposite side of the house for approximately two hours after his grandfather, Stan Earles went to work. That the defendant went back to her bedroom and slept in her bedroom which was approximately 65-85 feet away from her son's location after her father, identified as Stan Earls, left the residence at approximately 0830 hours. **That during this period of time, Zane Earles was left unattended, and a nine to twelve week old lab puppy that was left loose in the house ate the two-month-old victim.** The defendant has had a history of drug abuse and she was just recently taken off juvenile probation on 06/02/08 for drug charges. That while the victim was left unattended in the living room, the defendant was unable to wake up and hear her baby crying or screaming.

Your affiant prays that a search warrant be issued for the above described residence so that detectives might search the residence in order to obtain and conduct a decibel sound test to find out whether or not the infant's screams could have been heard while being eaten alive by the black lab puppy. Your affiant prays that a search warrant also be issued to search the above residence for any body fluids that may be left at the scene from the animal that tracked through the residence after eating the victim.


